Free School Meals

A message to ensure clarity around Free School Meals this academic year. We want to make the process clear, effective and reduce any queries you may have about funds issued through your child's account.

If your child is entitled to Free School Meals, £3.14 is loaded onto your child's dinner account daily. This amount cannot be seen on ParentMail, you will only be able to see the balance of any additional funds added to the account via card/PayPal. As this amount is loaded onto your child's account prior to lunch time, if any purchases are made at break time, then the charge will be taken from their FSM allowance. If this happens, then your child may not have enough FSM funds to purchase lunch, meaning additional funds would need to be added to their account to cover this.

For ± 3.14 , your child will be able to purchase the below meal deal.

Hot meal (e.g. Meal of the Day) Yoghurt, jelly pot or piece of fruit; or

Cold meal (e.g. sandwich) Yoghurt, jelly pot or piece of fruit Bottle of water

If you have any queries around any incorrect charges, please email: <u>info@pudseygrammar.co.uk</u> with full details, this will then be passed to the Finance Team to look into.

Children eligible for free school meals can take part in Healthy Holidays activities during the school holidays. Just a few quick reminders about some of our key routines:


- Students should be wearing their blazer at all times around the school and will be asked to take coats off on arrival to school.


GCSE Options


University of Sheffield
