# HEADTEACHER'S MESSAGE

Our first full week since the summer holidays has gone well with both students and staff getting back into our routines.

As you know, a key part of our new Behaviour system is the students' Attitude to Learning points. I am pleased to announce that our students have collectively achieved an impressive 151,671 positive Attitude To Learning (ATL) points this week. This remarkable accomplishment is a testament to their dedication, hard work, and commitment to their studies. We are incredibly proud of our students and their continued efforts to excel academically and personally.

Students achieve four ATL for every lesson they are in, if they meet our expectations. This means that attendance at school is extremely important if students want to maintain a high ATL score. We have organised a series of end of year rewards trips for next summer, but students will only be allowed to go if they have a high ATL score. Regular attendance also ensures that students do not miss out on valuable learning opportunities and are better prepared for their future endeavours. We encourage all parents to prioritise their child's attendance and to communicate with the school regarding any absences.



## **GENERAL NOTICES**

## **Absence Reporting**

Can we politely ask that medical/dental appointments are made outside of school hours wherever possible. Any appointments that are made for during the school day, will need to be supported with medical evidence such as a hospital letter, appointment card or prescription/prescribed medication. These should be emailed to us at <a href="mailto:attendance@pudseygrammar.co.uk">attendance@pudseygrammar.co.uk</a>. The Attendance Team should be informed in advance so that the absence can be recorded and authorised. Any absences without supporting evidence will not be authorised and could lead to your child's attendance being monitored.



## Unauthorised School Absence Monitoring – Years 7 – 11

The following changes came into force for Penalty Notice Fines from 19th August 2024 across the whole of England:

School MUST consider a penalty notice for 10 unauthorised absences (usually 5 school days) within a rolling 10 school week period of time (these sessions do not have to be consecutive and can be made up of any unauthorised absences and can span different terms and school years).

Penalty Notices are issued per parent, per child.


## **PSHE Form Time Schedule**



## Year 7


#### **Essential Equipment**


## YEAR 9

5.00pm - 5.25pm Presentation in the Main Hall from SLT and Director of Studies


5.35pm - 5.50pm Form Tutor session

#### Year 12


We would like to invite the families of new Year 12 students to our Parent Information Evening. The event will take place on Tuesday 17th September at 5.00pm and the session will cover:
