Year 10 INFUZE event

This Tuesday, we had the pleasure of welcoming the INFUZE Project to Pudsey Grammar School for a fantastic half-day workshop with 52 of our Year 10 Geographers, Artists, and Media students.

The INFUZE Project is an exciting national collaboration between the Royal College of Art, University of Leeds, Lancaster University, and over 20 industry partners and transport providers. Their mission is to engage young people in rethinking the future of transport, infrastructure, and public spaces.

During the session, students explored a range of local initiatives—including the redevelopment of New Pudsey Train Station, the proposed Leeds–Bradford tram system (which will run through Pudsey), and potential improvements to Pudsey Bus Station. The focus was on amplifying student voice in shaping the future of transport and how our urban spaces are designed.

All the ideas generated will be shared with local government and planning teams. The INFUZE team were incredibly impressed with the creativity, thoughtfulness, and ambition shown by our students throughout the workshop.

We're proud to see our students contributing to real-world conversations and solutions that could impact their own communities. If your child was involved, please take a moment to ask them about their ideas—they have a lot to be proud of!
