Go Ape Trip – Important Reminders

We recently held a meeting with students to go over key information. Please ensure the following:

Clothing: Students must wear comfortable, activewear. Go Ape states in their risk assessment that crop tops are not allowed.

Footwear: suitable footwear such as trainers - no crocs, sliders, or flip-flops.

Piercings: All piercings must be removed or covered with a plaster for safety. No jewellery allowed such as necklaces, rings and bracelets.

Medication: If your child requires daily medication (e.g. inhalers), they must bring it with them.

Lunch: All students need to bring a packed lunch. If your child is entitled to free school meals, a grab bag will be provided.
