## 16–19 Bursary Fund Student Information Leaflet 2025–2026

### What is the 16–19 Bursary?

The 16–19 Bursary provides financial support to help students overcome financial barriers so they can remain in sixth form education.

### Who can apply?

Students may be eligible if they are in care or a care leaver; receive Income Support, Universal Credit, ESA, DLA or PIP in their own name; come from a household with an income below £28,500; were eligible for free school meals in Year 11; or have specific education-related financial needs.

### How much can I receive?

Students in vulnerable groups may receive up to £1,200 per year. Discretionary awards vary depending on individual circumstances and available funding.

### What can the bursary help pay for?

- Travel to and from school
- Meals during the school day
- Books, equipment and learning resources
- Course-related trips and university open days

### Conditions of support

Students must maintain at least 90% attendance, meet academic expectations and follow school behaviour policies. Failure to do so may result in support being reduced or withdrawn.

### How do I apply?

Complete the online bursary application form on the school website and upload the required evidence. Applications for 2025–2026 should be submitted by 12 September 2025.
